It cares for more than 32,500 animals representing nearly 1500 species including fish, marine mammals, birds, snakes, amphibians, and insects. The aquarium has received awards for best exhibit from the Association of Zoos and Aquariums for Seahorse Symphony, Amazon Rising in, and Wild Reef.*
